The Sweepfast System 2m Brush



The following operation needs to take place when the surface is completely dry. As organic and atmospheric contaminants are generally lighter than infill sands, they will be gradually graded to the top of the surface during the following operations.

This system although developed mainly for use on sand based systems works on most sand dressed and water based carpets. It can also be used on rubber crumb filled carpets although the greensweep may collect too much rubber crumb.

The Brushes are designed to be weighted with standard size 17kg goal post weights brush strips of different length and stiffness can be ordered to suit specific requirements. A 1metre triangular brush is also available for more aggressive brushing.

- 1) Brush the surface with the yellow side of the brush downwards and the weights on board. This may need doing several times in different directions to de-compact the top of the carpet and bring the sand to the surface.
- 2) Remove the weights, reverse the brush (now white bristles down) and connect a 2m cleansweep to the brush using the provided R clip, work the surface in both directions.
- 3) Groom the surface with the cleansweep on its own, this will put the sand back into the carpet.
- 4) Greensweep the pitch to collect the debris that has been graded onto the surface by previous operations, take care not to overload the greensweep or hit anything hard as it will break! Travelling at between 2.5 and 5 mph will generate a static charge on the Greensweep mat; this charge will attract broken fibres from the surface.
- 5) Empty debris regularly from the Greensweep, at a collection point, using the handles at the back.

If possible store both Cleansweep and Greensweep mats flat on the floor when not in use.
